NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING to RENEW Conditional Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Grazing Operations in the Tomales Bay Watershed

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will hold a public hearing on **October 10, 2018** to consider renewing the 2013 Conditional Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Grazing Operations in the Tomales Bay Watershed (2013 Waiver). The 2013 Waiver applies to existing and potential future grazing operations within the Tomales Bay watershed. The proposed resolution to renew the Conditional Waiver does not expand the scope or requirements of the 2013 Waiver.

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SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN COMMENTS: The 30-day public comment period for the proposed Conditional Waiver begins on August 3, 2018. Comment letters must be received by 5:00 PM, on Tuesday, September 4, 2018. Please send all written comments on the proposed Conditional Waiver to the staff contact identified above. Additionally, all evidence, testimony, and exhibits to be offered at the hearing must be submitted in writing by this date to the above staff contact. Non-evidentiary policy statements to be made at the hearing need not be submitted in advance.

Prior to the hearing, Water Board staff will post to the above website any proposed changes to the proposed Conditional Waiver, along with written responses to all comments received during the public comment period. Any changes in the date of the hearing or any other updates will also be noticed on the above website.

The Water Board will receive oral public testimony on the proposed Conditional Waiver at the hearing. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Water Board will consider adoption of the proposed Conditional Waiver, including changes that are consistent with the general purpose of the proposed Conditional Waiver and are a logical outgrowth of the evidence and testimony received. Alternatively, in response to written comments and testimony received, the Water Board may recommend that staff make changes to the proposed Conditional Waiver to be presented for its consideration at a subsequent hearing.

The public hearing will be conducted in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, Title 23 section 649.3. Time limits may be imposed on oral testimony at the public hearing and groups are encouraged to designate a spokesperson. All Exhibits presented at the hearing including charts, graphs, and other testimony must be left with the Water Board and will become part of the administrative record.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party that challenges the Water Board's action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections that were raised before the Water Board at the public hearing or in timely submitted written correspondence.
